Activity Packs

Activity packs are handed out through our Happy Wheels program to families in the pediatric areas of the hospital. These items provide a small comfort and distraction for families during long days at the hospital.

Directions:

- Volunteers **purchase** 4-5 items appropriate for children to play with in the hospital
- All items must go in a clear gallon-sized Ziploc bag (the bag does not have to zip)
- Please **DO NOT** include food items or sharp items (scissors, stapler/staples, etc.)
- Please do not label activity packs with age and/or gender
- Holiday specific activity packs should be dropped off 2 weeks before the holiday to allow time for processing and delivery to the hospital

What to include in Activity Packs:

- Activity packs may be geared towards infants, toddlers, school-aged children, and teens
- See items below for suggestions for each age range

Infant items:

- Teething ring
- Board book
- Lovey
- Rattle
- Pacifier

Toddler items:

- Cars
- Small blocks
- Stickers/tattoos
- Books
- Play-doh

School age items: Teen items:

- Coloring book
- Crayons
- Play-doh
- Notebook
- Travel-sized games
- Puzzle books
- Adult coloring books
- Colored pencils
- Card games
- Headphones
