




In-Hospital Ronald McDonald House

Our In-Hospital Programs

Ronald McDonald Family Rooms

These spaces offer a place for families to rest and relax, just steps from their child's hospital room.

Our Family Room at Bon Secours St. Mary's Hospital includes a kitchen area and two sleep rooms within the hospital.

In 2024, we opened our **Family Room at HCA Johnston-Willis Hospital**, marking a milestone for our organization with our first programs south of the James River.





Hospitality Carts and Kiosk

Our Hospitality Carts at CHoR, St. Mary's, and Johnston-Willis roll through the hospital hallways offering snacks, activities, and other small comforts to families with children in pediatric and neonatal care units.

In 2024, we opened our **Ronald McDonald Hospitality Kiosk** in the NICU of Bon Secours St. Francis Medical Center. This new program serves as a convenient, stationary version of our Hospitality Carts.

Ronald McDonald House Sibling Center

The **RMHC Sibling Center** reduces stress and inspires fun by providing a safe, developmentally appropriate environment for brothers and sisters of children receiving treatment at CHoR, allowing their parents to focus on their child's medical care.

Lunches with Love

Five days a week, meal volunteers prepare lunches that are distributed to CHoR and St Mary's Hospital, allowing families to enjoy fresh, nutritious food free of charge without leaving the hospital.
